After 4 years of being unable to travel due to COVID, we had an amazing time of reunion, celebration and reminders of God's faithfulness to us. It was hard for us to support Luke from afar and we missed not being able to see him in person during his Summer, Spring and Christmas vacations from school. A few weeks later, Luke began his new job as a disabilities case manager who helps secure long-term housing for his clients. The job is challenging, but Luke seems to enjoy it. As parents, the best part is that the job includes full benefits: dental, health insurance & retirement! This is a huge answer to prayer. We are proud of our son and very thankful to God.

While in Southern California we were able to visit 5 supporting churches and share about the ministry in Japan. We truly sensed God's faithfulness to all 5 churches.
